



CODE OF CONDUCT FOR CLUB

Football is the national game. All those involved in the game at every level, whether as a player, match official, coach, owner or administrator, has a responsibility, above and beyond compliance with the law, to act according to the highest standards of integrity and to ensure that the reputation of the game is, and remains, high. To this end this code applies to the Club and its members.

COMMUNITY

Football, at all levels, is an integral part of the local community. The Club will consider community feeling when making decisions.

EQUALITY

The Club is opposed to discrimination of any form and will promote measures to prevent it, in whatever form, from being expressed. See the Anti Discrimination policy.

PARTICIPANTS

The club recognises the sense of ownership of all those participating within the club, be they players, coaches, club officials, match officials and supporters. The club is committed to appropriate consultation.

YOUNG PEOPLE

The club acknowledges the extent of football's influence on young people and pledges to set a positive example.

PROPRIETY

The club acknowledges that the highest standards of financial and administrative behaviour are demanded and will not tolerate corruption or improper practices.

TRUST AND RESPECT

The club will uphold a relationship of trust with all those involved within the club, whatever their status within the club.

VIOLENCE

The club rejects the use of violence of any nature by anyone involved with the club.

FAIRNESS

The club is committed to fairness in its dealings with all those involved in the game.

INTEGRITY AND FAIR PLAY

The club is committed to the principle of playing to win, consistent with fair play.
